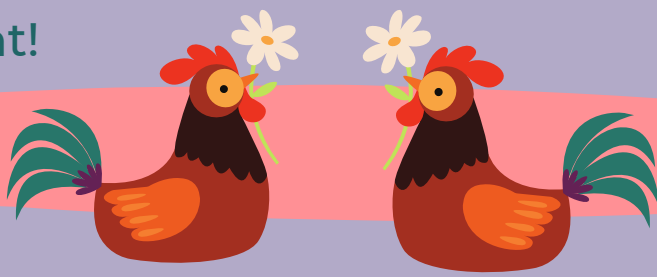


Fun Facts About Roosters
